TOWN OF FORT WINNEBAGO

GENERAL PENALTY PROVISIONS ORDINANCE

The Town Board of the Town of Fort Winnebago, Columbia County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Violations and Penalties. Except where a penalty is provided elsewhere under the Town's ordinances, any person who shall violate any Town ordinance shall, upon conviction of such violation, be subject to a penalty, which shall be as follows:

- A. First offense. Any person found guilty of violating a Town ordinance or any part of a Town ordinance, who has not previously been convicted of a violation of the same ordinance within one (1) year prior to such violation, shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$50 nor more than \$500, together with the costs of prosecution.
- B. Second and subsequent offenses. Any person found guilty of violating any Town ordinance or part of a Town ordinance, who shall previously have been convicted of a violation of the same ordinance within one year shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000 for each such offense, together with costs of prosecution.

<u>SECTION 2. Continued Violations.</u> Each violation and each day a violation continues or occurs shall constitute a separate offense. Nothing in this Ordinance shall preclude the Town from maintaining any appropriate action to prevent or remove a violation of any Town ordinance.

SECTION 3. Other Remedies. The Town shall have any and all other remedies afforded by the Wisconsin Statutes in addition to the forfeiture and costs of prosecution above.

SECTION 4. Authority. This article is adopted pursuant to §66.0109 and 66.0113(3) *Wis. Stats.*

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance is effective on publication or posting, as provided by law.
