**RESOLUTION  
CHANGING NUMBER OF ELECTION OFFICIALS  
FOR THE  
TOWN OF FORT WINNEBAGO**

**WHEREAS**, the Town is a body corporate and politic within Columbia County, Wisconsin; and, Section 7.32, Wisconsin Statutes allows a municipal governing body to reduce the required number of election officials at a polling place from seven (7) to no less than three (3).

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board desires to adopt a Resolution reducing the number of election officials at the polling place from seven (7) to no less than three (3), and the town board has determined that it would be advantageous to the town to have only as many election officials on duty as are needed for a given election.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Town Board of the Town of Fort Winnebago, Columbia County, Wisconsin by this resolution adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and property notice have been given, resolves and declares as follows:

**There shall be a minimum of three (3) election officials on duty at every election. At the discretion of the town clerk, the requested number of election officials may be increased for any election. However, the number of election officials working at a given election shall always be an odd number.**

The Town Clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under §60.80, *Wis. Stats.*
